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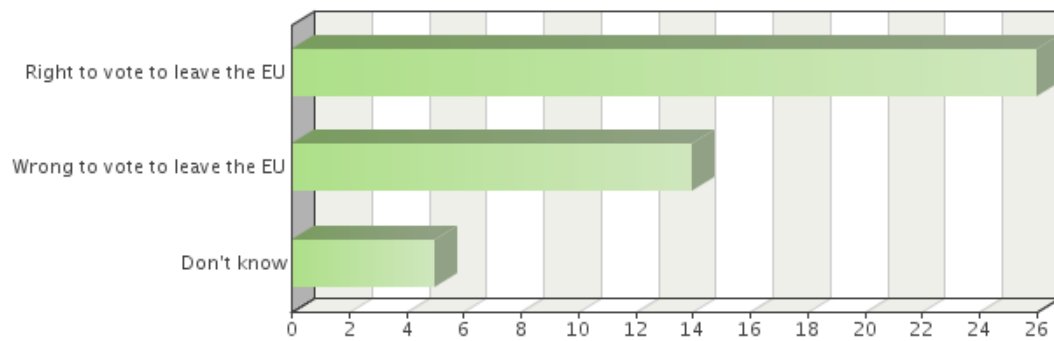

In hindsight, do you think Britain was right or wrong to vote to leave the European Union?



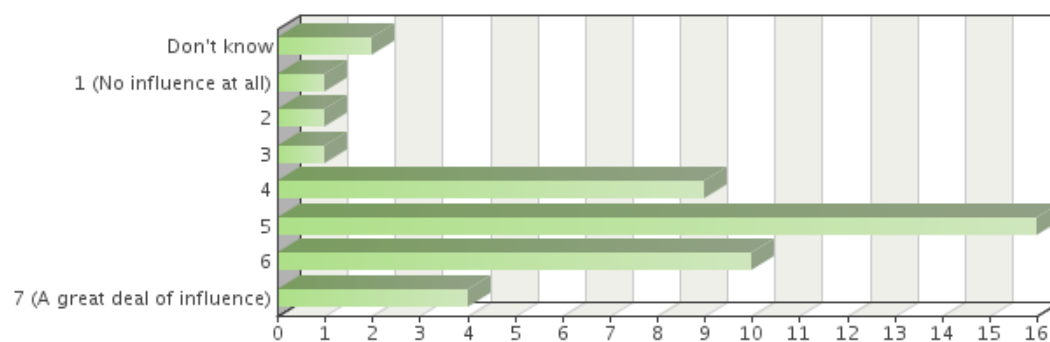

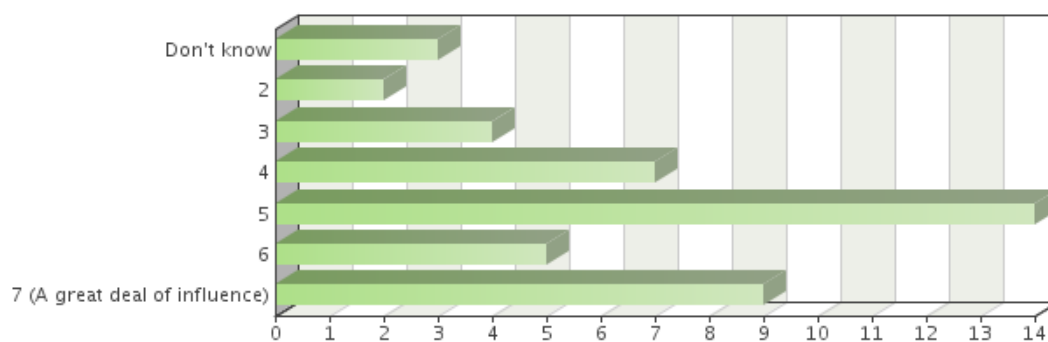

An assembly of citizens that has been randomly selected to represent all members of society

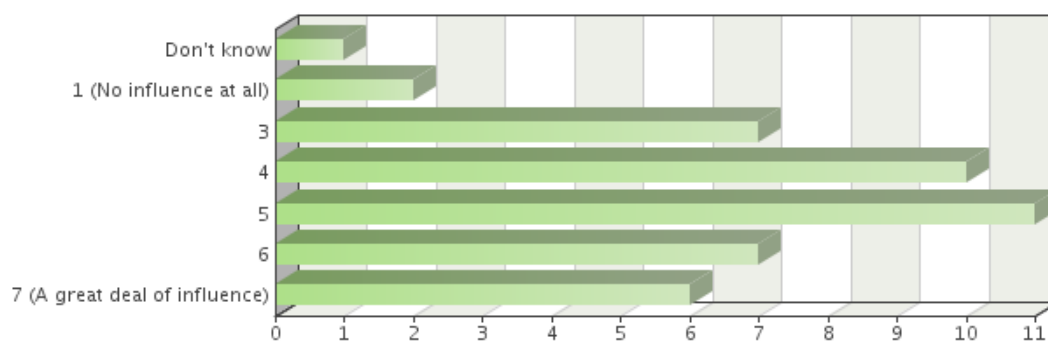

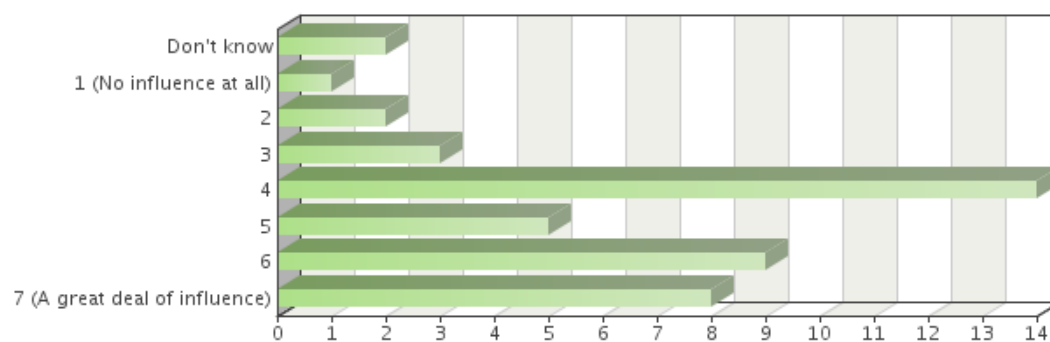

Parliament

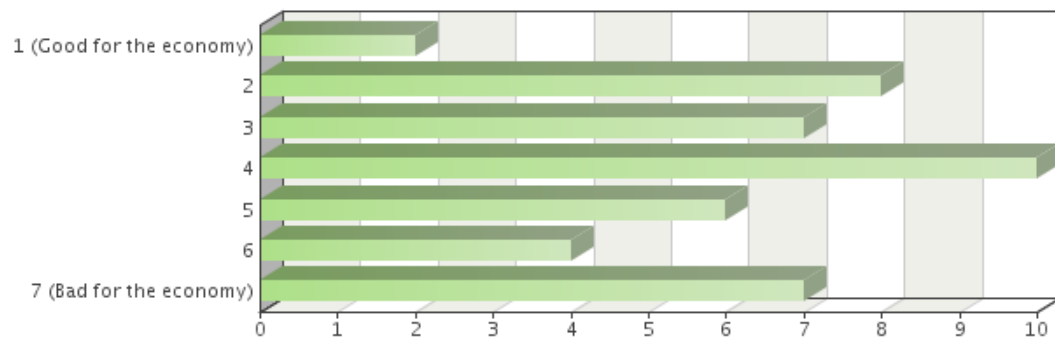

Do you think immigration is good or bad for Britain's economy?

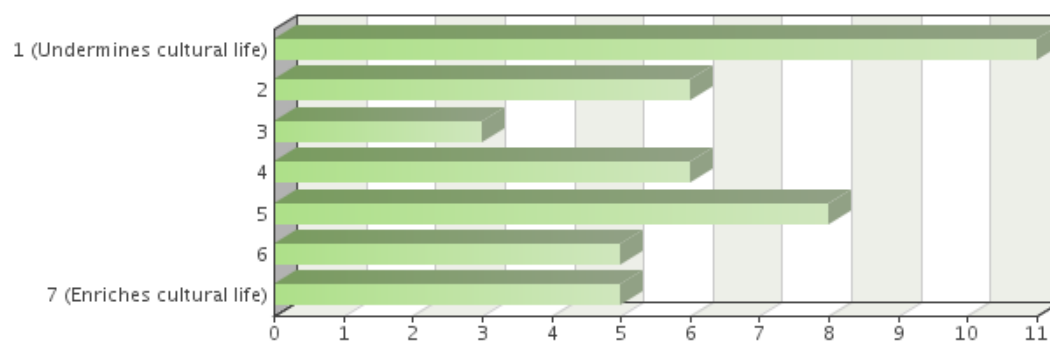

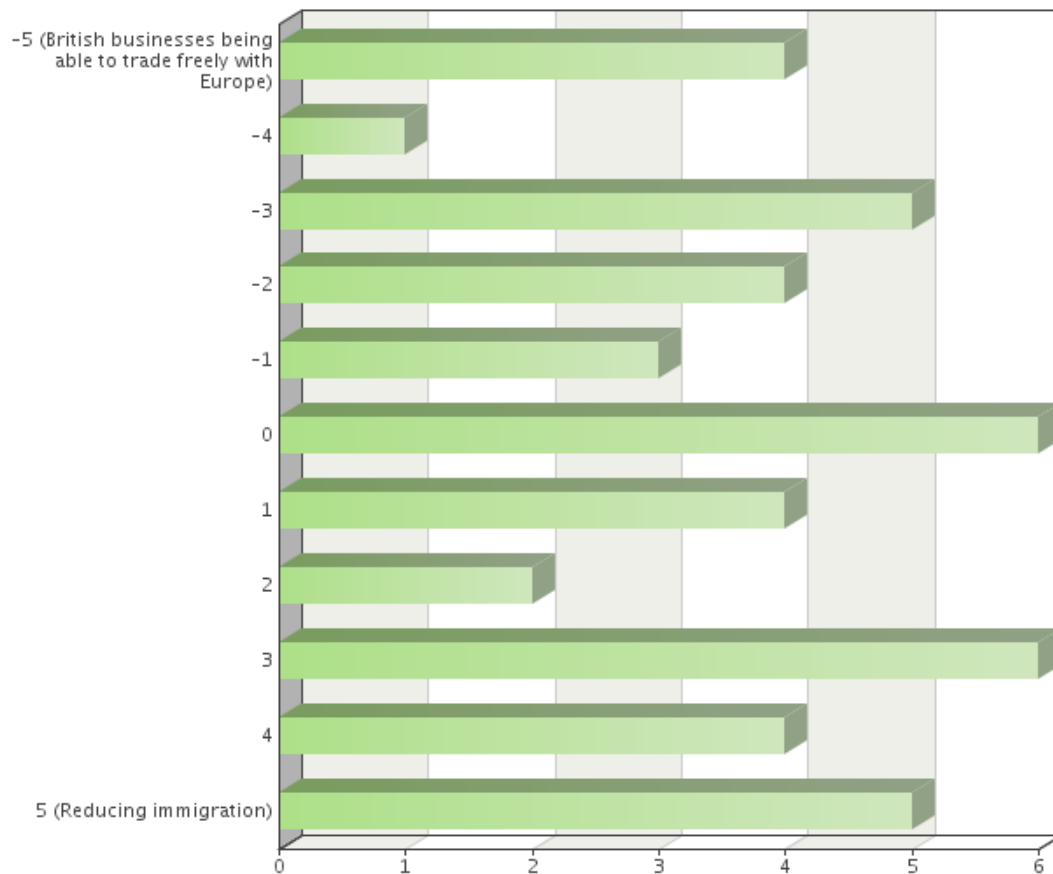

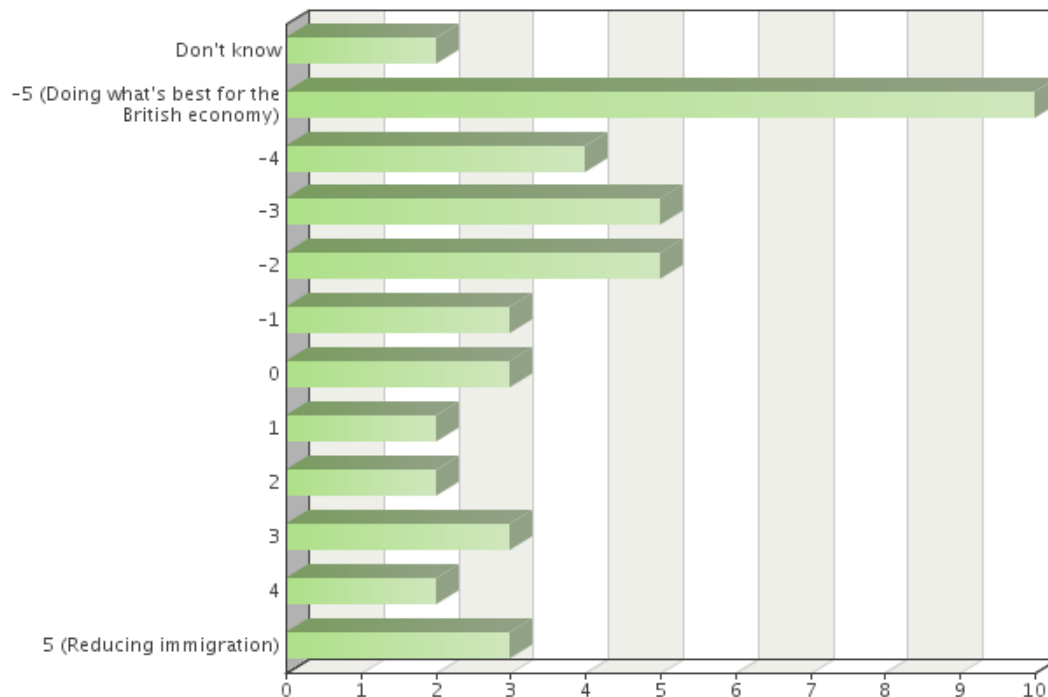

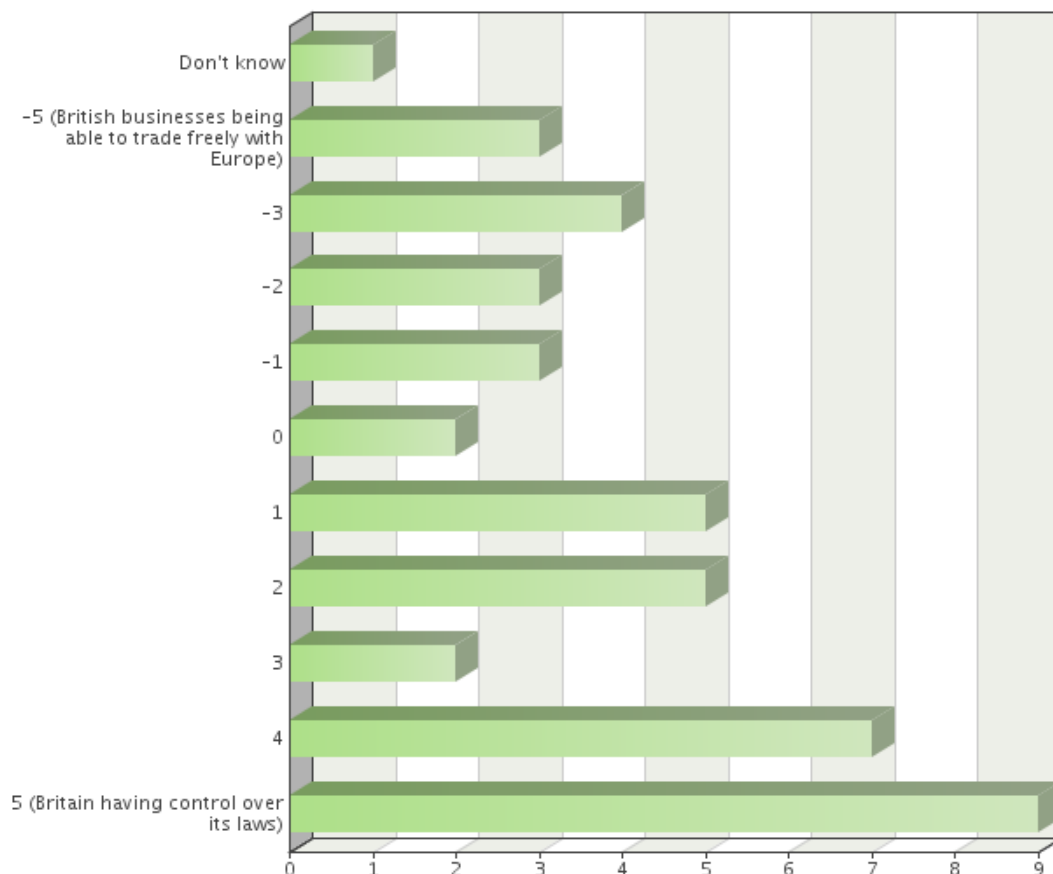

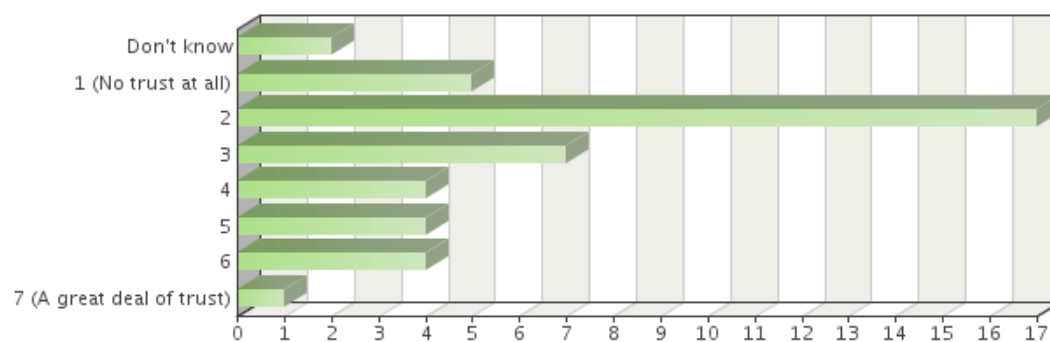

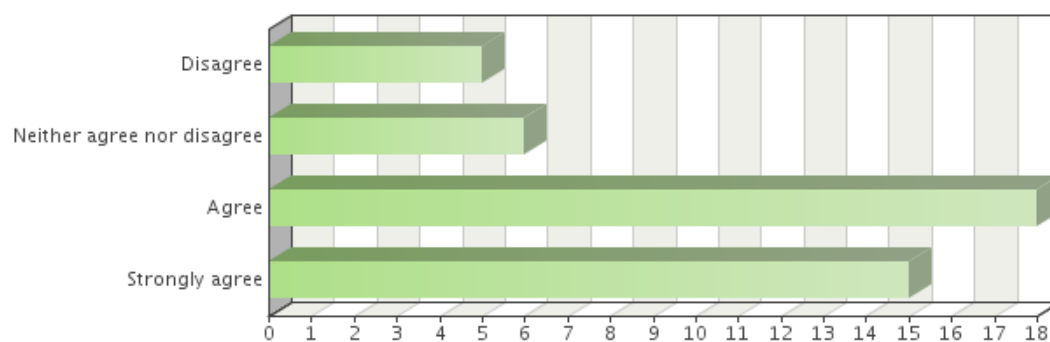

Politicians don't care what people like me think

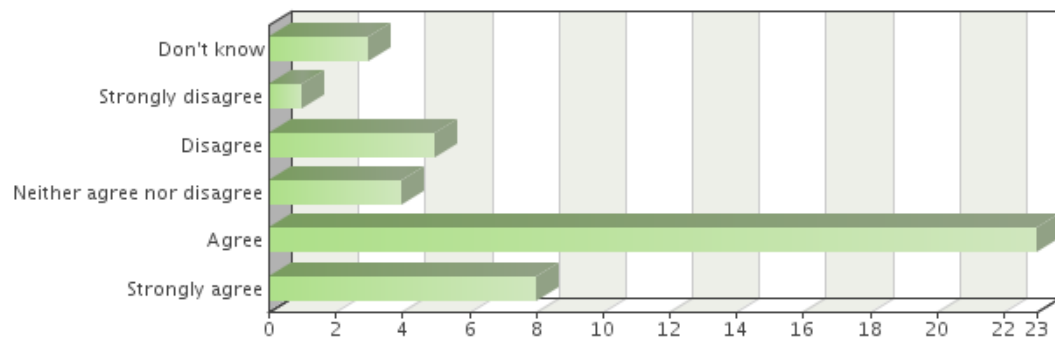

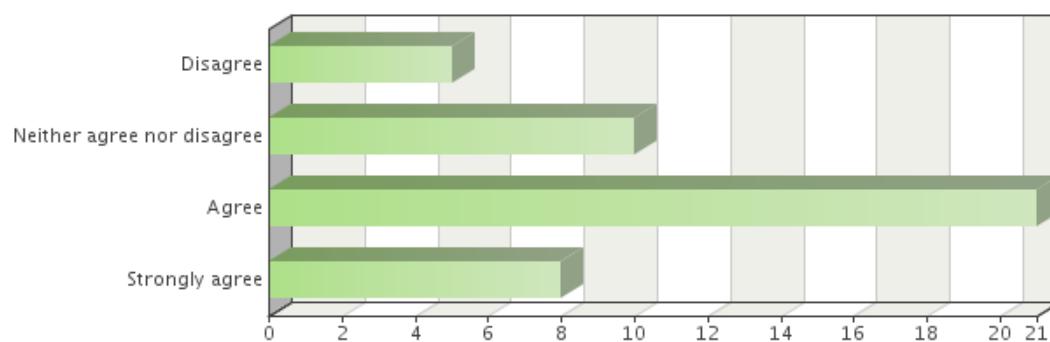

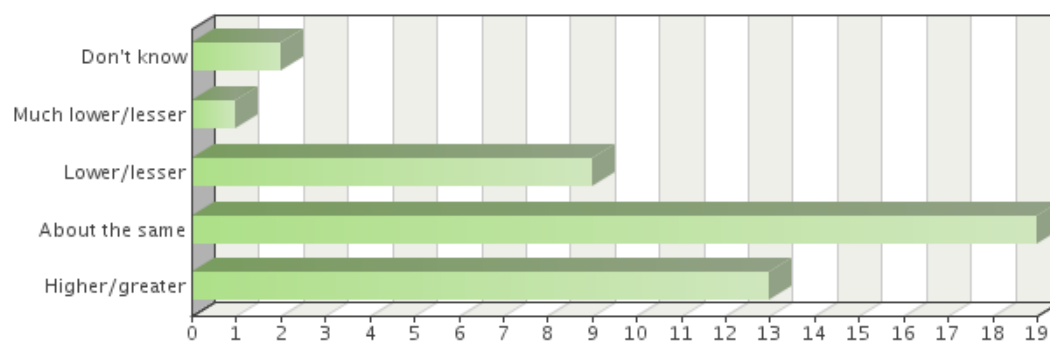

Unemployment



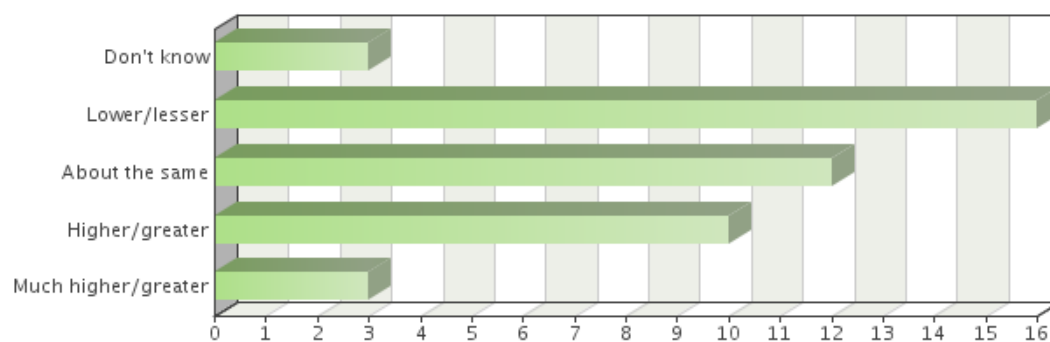

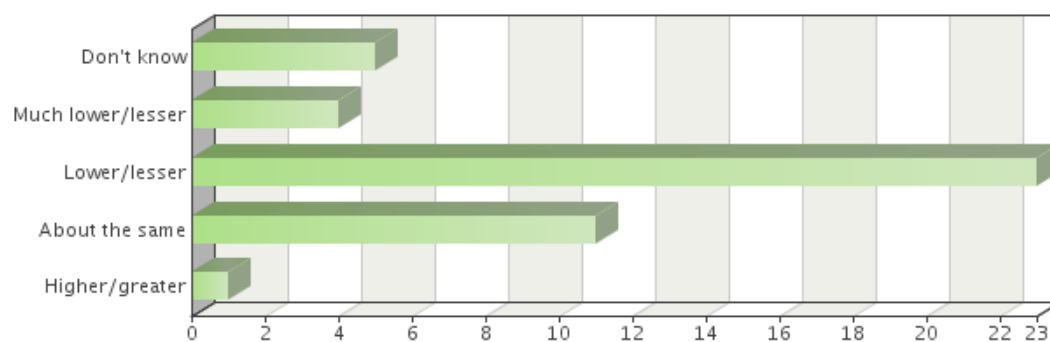

Immigration to the UK



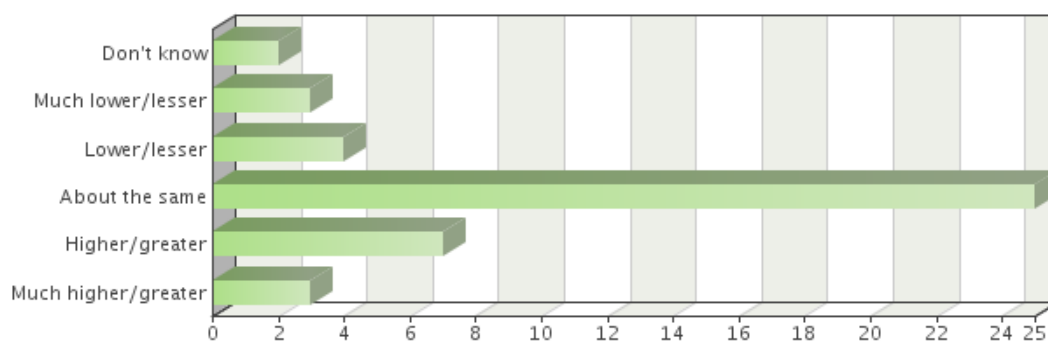

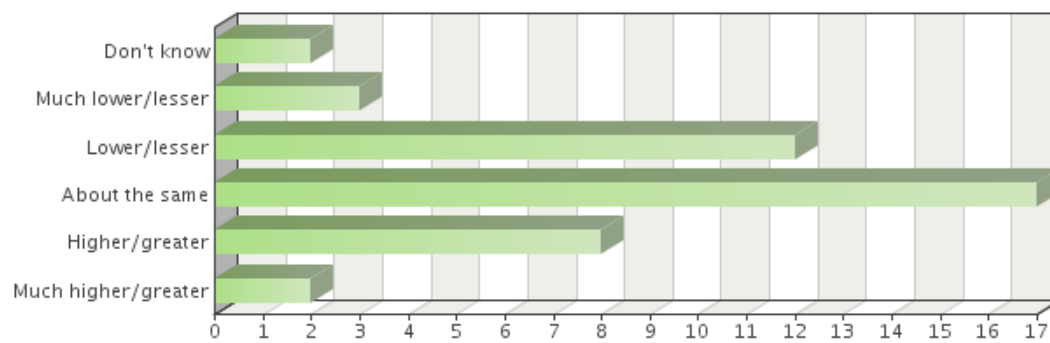

Britain's influence in the world



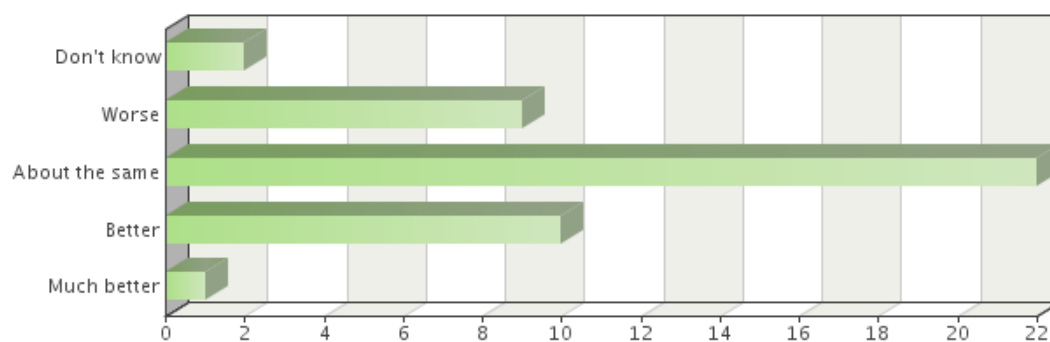

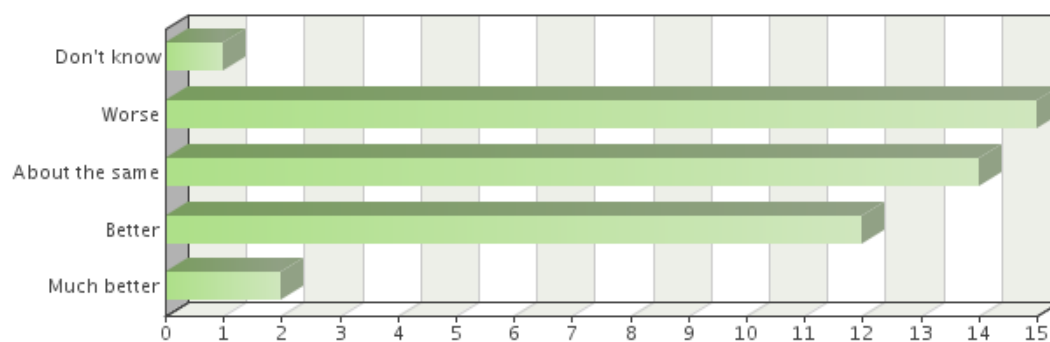

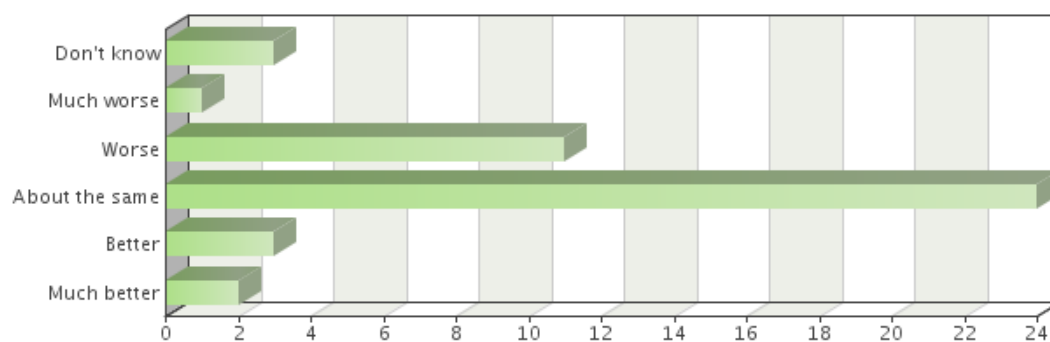

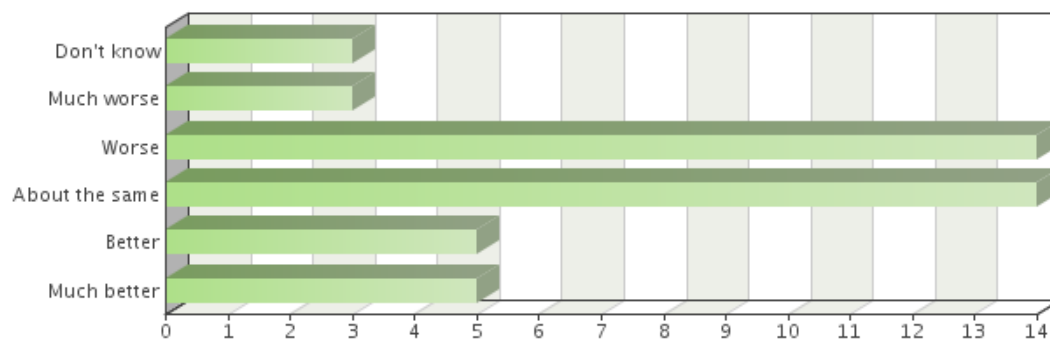

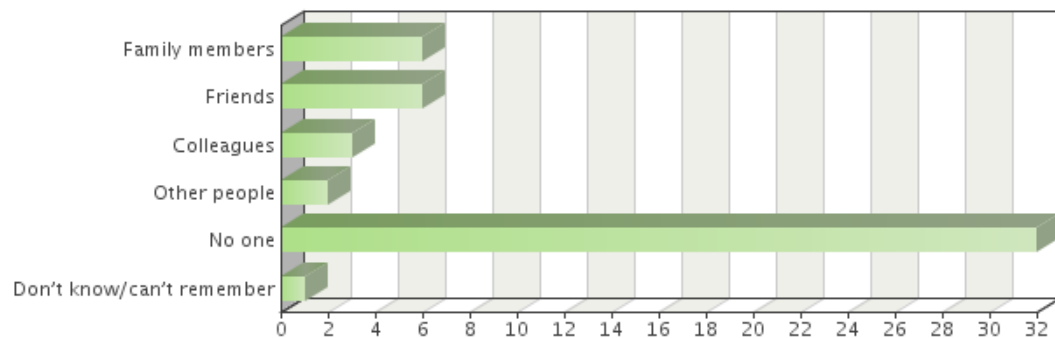

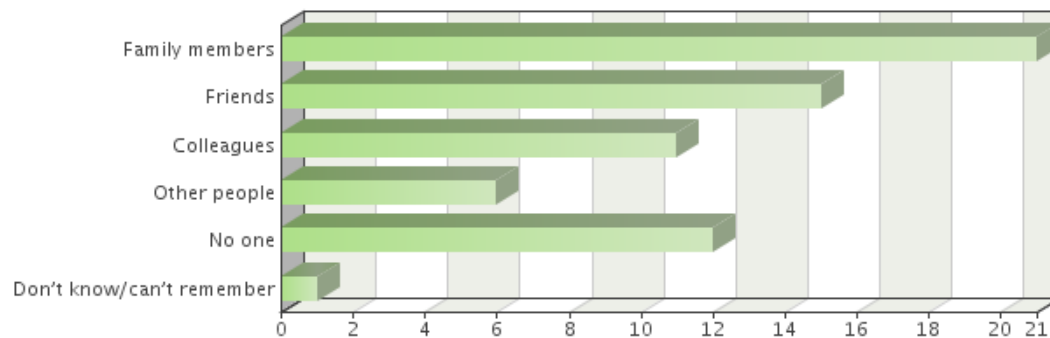

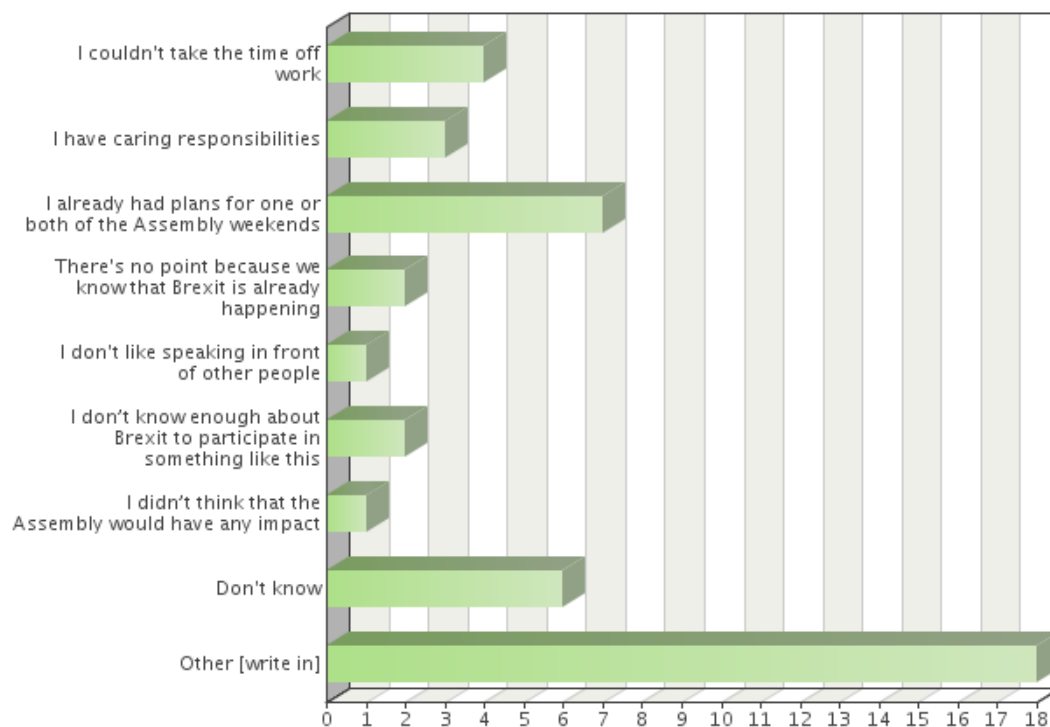
