

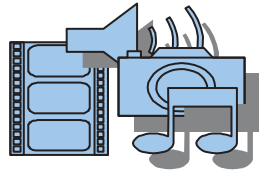
# Growing up as a Muslim

**Would you like to talk to us about growing up as a Muslim?**

We are researchers who work at Cardiff University and some of us are Muslims too. We are really interested in how children learn about Islam in their families. We'd like to interview you, your parents and maybe other people in your family. We'd also like some children to keep diaries and take photographs for us – we can lend you a recorder and a camera so you can do this.



If you would like to do this, no-one would know who you were, because when we write a book about what we've found out, we'll use pretend names for everyone. So if your name is Sameh we will call you something like 'Ali' instead. And we won't put any photos of people in the book. All your words would be typed up (with pretend names) and would be kept safe in case other people working in universities ask to have a look at them.

We can speak Arabic, Urdu and Punjabi (and English!). If there's another language you'd like to speak then we could find someone else to translate. Would you like to get yourself and your family involved in our project? Why don't you talk to your parents about it and get them to give us a call?
