

The Growth in Grammar Corpus – User Agreement

The *Growth in Grammar Corpus* (GiG) is expressly intended for use within two contexts: in the context of further research seeking to better understand the nature of language development, and in educational contexts seeking to enhance students' linguistic development. As such, access to *GiG* is granted solely for use within these two contexts. Furthermore,

Any and all usage must target the linguistic dimensions of the corpus. For example, *GiG* may be used to better understand how language can express attitudes towards social relations or to help students better develop the linguistic resources for expressing such attitudes; it may not be used to explore the nature of the attitudes themselves.

Any and all usage must conform to the requirements stipulated in the current ethical guidelines for the *British Educational Research Association*. Of particular importance is clause 9 of these guidelines, which states that researchers 'should operate within an ethic of respect for any persons involved in the research they are undertaking. Individuals should be treated fairly, sensitively, with dignity, and within an ethic of respect and freedom from prejudice regardless of age, gender, sexuality, race, ethnicity, class, nationality, cultural identity, partnership status, faith, disability, political belief or any other significant difference'. For present purposes, "individuals" are taken to be any persons connected to the texts within *GiG*, whether directly or indirectly, together with the schools from which the *GiG* texts were originally drawn.

Any and all usage must respect the anonymity of all individuals connected with the *GiG* texts, except where such individuals are recognised figures within the public domain (e.g. politicians and celebrities). Any attempt to identify persons using information contained within *GiG* is strictly forbidden. Furthermore, whilst every effort has been made to anonymise *GiG* material, should a user encounter a text where they feel this anonymity may have been compromised, they must immediately bring this text to that attention of the *GiG* team.

I hereby recognise

- that my access to *GiG* is granted solely for the purposes for which this access was requested, and that this access extends to the use of *GiG* by additional individuals only where such individuals are directly connected to the purposes for which this access was requested.
- that I take sole responsibility for any usage that follows on from my being granted access to *GiG*, and for ensuring that all usage by any additional individuals is in accordance with the conditions specified in the current agreement.
- that I may not redistribute or sell my access to *GiG*.
- that my authorisation to use *GiG* may be withdrawn at any time, though only for substantive reasons (e.g. violation of the present agreement).
- that any use of *GiG* must be explicitly referenced within any resulting publications or reports, as specified on the project website.
- that my access to *GiG* is subject to the conditions set out in the present agreement, and that any violation of these conditions puts me in breach of the *Data Protection Act* (1998).
