What is this study and why is it being carried out?

This is an urgent public health study funded by the UKRI Economic and Social Research Council to help understand the attitudes of university students to COVID-19 vaccines and to assess the best mechanisms for delivery of vaccines to students such as 'on campus' vaccination programmes.

The research team are working with a range of health regulators in the UK. Information collected in the study will be utilised for making recommendations to local and national Government on COVID-19 vaccination policies for the University of Leicester and other universities.

Why should I take part?

The research team want to hear from a wide spectrum of undergraduate university students. They are particularly keen to hear from international students and people of ethnic minorities in order to assess the impact of a broad range of pandemic experiences on vaccine uptake among students.

What are the possible disadvantages and risks of taking part?

You should not experience any discomforts, disadvantages or risks as a result of taking part in the questionnaire.

What are the possible benefits of taking part?

There are no immediate benefits for research participants. However, it is hoped that this work will help with optimizing the delivery of COVID-19 vaccination programmes to students at UK universities.

If I take part, what will I be asked to do?

The questionnaire will take approximately 15 minutes to complete. You will also be asked if you would like to participate in a 1:1 in-depth interview.
