Dataset C13. Spatial Borderland Biography Colombia

Geodatabase created to support the research by the Drugs and (dis)order project, investigating the social-political dimensions of illicit drug economies in the context of war to peace transitions in the borderlands of Colombia.

The geodatabase contains spatial data for the borderland areas studied on research sites, border crossings, narcotics (coca production), borderland points of interest, administrative boundaries, population, transport and road networks, infrastructure (mining areas, cell towers, visible lights at night), agriculture and hydrology.

Data layers are sourced from existing geospatial data layers, Open Street Map and created from satellite images.

Information on provenance and how each data layer was created, with baseline data sources used, is included in the metadata for each layer within the geodatabase. All layers are also listed in the data register attached.
