Do you think the parcel van service has been affected by the pandemic and the Ukrainian war? If yes/no, how/why not?

How do you feel your/Moldovan parcel-sending might change in the future, especially in the event of another crisis? What do you feel was the role of Moldovans abroad in helping Ukrainian refugees?
